SAUL'S B.C. & D.C. STORY (Read 9:1-19a)

- Summarize the highlights of Saul's remarkable conversion experience.
- What is our conversion experience? Share our story noting differences and similarities between them because of Christ our Saviour and Lord.

Take a moment to thank God for what He has done in our lives. Pray that we will *'continue to live in Him, rooted and built up in Him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness'* (Colossians 2:6).

SAUL'S A.C. STORY (Read 9:19b – 31)

Jesus said, *"I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full"* (John 10:10). It's one thing to begin the Christian life but another to live it to the full.

- Why did Saul [*Paul*] as a sincere believer fail to be an effective Christian after conversion? What relevance has this for us?
- How did Saul [*Paul*] become an effective Christian living in the blessing of God and blessing other people? How is this relevant to us?
- What does it mean to live by the principle: ***'Nothing coming from me, everything coming from Christ?'***

TAKE-AWAY – What truth will we take away from Saul to Paul's BC, DC and AC experience? Pray about this.
