DIRECTIONS & MAP TO HEADLANDS ADVENTURE CENTRE

Headlands Adventure Centre is situated approximately 1/2 mile north of Ringwood along Salisbury Road, A338.

SatNav:

If you are using satellite navigation to find your way, use the following postcode which will take you *roughly* to the correct location - BH24 3PB. If you are not hi-tech enough to have SatNav, then you will have to follow the instructions and use the map below:

Directions from Ringwood:

Turn off the A31 at Ringwood and follow signs for the A338, signposted 'Salisbury Fordingbridge'. Approximately 1/2 mile northbound along the A338, (200m after The Town and Country Experience), look out for the CBC sail-flag which will be positioned directly opposite the entrance of the camp site.

When you see the sail-flag, turn right into Headlands Adventure Centre. The turning is immediately opposite a red Wilts & Dorset bus stop into a small service road. The entrance gateway is between houses. Follow the gravel track until you find the parking area amongst the trees.

If you pass the Shell petrol station/Budgen's or Headlands Business Park, then you have gone just too far and need to turn around.
