



From Glory to Glory | 2 Corinthians 3:7-18

1. Read 2 Corinthians 3:7-18 together, is there a particular theme, verse, question or challenge that stands out to you? Share any thoughts you have.
2. V7-11 What contrasts does Paul draw between the old covenant and the new covenant in 2 Corinthians 3:7–11? How does this comparison help us understand the difference between the law and the gospel?
3. In what ways are we in danger of slipping into an ‘old covenant’ mindset today? (trying harder, earning approval?) Do you tend to relate to God more through performance or grace? How does understanding grace help us live differently?
4. V12-16 Do you remember the moment when the ‘veil’ was removed, and you understood the gospel? Are there areas of your life where you still might need God to reveal his truth or where you are resisting his truth? Stop and pray about these things together.
5. V17&18 According to Paul where is freedom found? What kind of freedom is he describing? Are you using your freedom to draw closer to God – or drifting from him?
6. ‘We become what we love and who we love shapes what we become.’ Share honestly about the things that you spend time on that take you away from time with God? What can you put in place to be more intentional about spending time with God?
7. In what ways have you seen God gradually change you over time, not just behavioural change but heart transformation? Where do you long to see more transformation?
8. How does transformation happen not just individually but corporately? How can or does our church community reflect God’s glory together? How can we encourage others in their “from glory to glory” journey?
9. As we move into the Beacon Centre, what practical steps could we take as a church family or as a small group to seek God’s presence together and seek to be transformed into his likeness with ever increasingly glory? Pray together about these things.
