

Devotement | A Call To...Serve | 1 Peter 4:1-11

- 1. How would you define a fully committed follower of Jesus? What does one look like in the everyday world of Christchurch?
- 2. Sharing with genuine humility (not declaring yourself to be less or more than you are), which areas of your Christian life are going well for you? Where are you flourishing?
- 3. Are there any areas where your Christian walk is more of a struggle? Try to be vulnerable but only share what you feel comfortable sharing.
- 4. Has there been one book or resource which has particularly encouraged you in your Christian walk? What is it?
- 5. Read 1 Peter 4:1-11. Discuss the context. What stands out to you from the text? Why?
- 6. Chris said Peter's message in verses 1-6 is 'Stop sinning'. In verses 7-11, his message is 'start serving'. Why do you think this message was significant for a suffering church?
- 7. Does Peter think Jesus was about to return, or, that his listeners were about to die, or, both? Discuss. How should this message challenge the 21st Century church?
- 8. Duncan Campbell, a Scottish Church Minister, once spoke of being 'well-saved'. What does a well-saved person look like according to Peter?
- 9. How is 'loving others deeply' an act of service? Can you think of an occasion when someone has done this for you?
- 10. Discus being 'hospitable without grumbling'. Why can hospitality be so hard today? What does good hospitality even look like, especially if it is not primarily about throwing dinner parties?
- 11. What strategies are you deploying to be a selfLESS person in a selfie world?
- 12. Read verses 10-11 again. How do these verses challenge you and especially your motivation for serving others well? What should our motivation be?
