Giving Summary as at 31 August 2024

Year To Date Giving Received: **£64,234**

Year To Date Giving in Budget: £59,335

The chart above shows offerings to the General Fund, which is used for CBC's day-to-day running costs. Back in March, Church Members agreed that the target budget for the year beginning 1 April 2024 should be to increase General Fund offerings by 5% over the year before.

Based on the first five months of this year, there is a gap of around £5,700 between the target budget and the actual offerings received. It would be great if that gap did not grow and could even start to close, so that CBC meets its day-to-day running costs. Please remember that the CBC does not receive any funding from denominational groups and we rely entirely on your offerings to meet our costs.

We know that many of you have made sacrifices to give regularly to the Project 5:1 Building Fund, for which we are immensely grateful. The Building Fund and the General Fund are held separately in different accounts for different purposes and do not overlap. Hence, despite that incredible generosity towards our new building, we need to also remind you about your giving to the General Fund, so we can fully meet the regular running costs over this year.

Please review any general offerings, whether made by standing order, cash or contactless, to see whether any can be increased to achieve that overall target of 5%. Perhaps the reintroduction of cash offerings from Sunday 06 October will be a helpful step...
