Message From Christchurch Foodbank+ - Happy New Year. We want to say thank you from our hearts and from everyone we have the privilege of working with and showing God's love and the communities love too. We felt such anger and sadness when we were burgled before Christmas and then we were overwhelmed with all the love and support for 'our community foodbank'. We blessed 100 isolated and vulnerable individuals with a full Christmas dinner on Christmas day, 98 people at our Christmas community supper shared dinner and carols, 86 families had a turkey and all the trimmings delivered for Christmas Day, over 250 children were blessed with toys and books, and we gave out school holiday hunger top up bags feeding 708 people and 289 goodie hampers/bags. We couldn't do it without you so thank you and God Bless you abundantly in 2025. Tracy, Sarah, John and our amazing team.
