1. Why might God's Love be described as 'Scandalous' based on His instructions to Hosea and Old Testament morality and The Commandments? (chapter 1:1-3)
2. How does God's Love - demonstrated in His instructions to Hosea, re Gomer (1:2-3; 3:1-4) - parallel His love as a Father, as depicted in Chapter 11:1-11?
3. Why are the names of Gomer's children (1:4-11) significant to God, Hosea, Gomer and Israel?
4. How does Chapter 11:8-9 speak to us about the Faithfulness of a Loving Father God?
5. How does this little prophetic book bring reassurance to each one of us and why?
6. What did/does it mean to be "Called to 'Come Back' to God" - for the Israelites and for you and I?
7. Are you willing to share about a time when you needed to 'Come Back' to God? How did it happen?
8. Our Church Pastors and Leaders noted in the recent Week of Prayer that The Lord was speaking to us about deeper 'Consecration'. What does that look like?
