

Zaccheus: A Holy Interruption | Luke 19:1-10

- 1. How do you usually react to unexpected interruptions? Are you spontaneous, calm, or protective of your plans? Share a time when an interruption turned out to be a blessing.
- 2. Read: Luke 19:1-10

Zaccheus: One Man Seeking (vv.1-4)

3. What do we learn about Zacchaeus' status, wealth, and reputation? What might have stirred Zacchaeus' curiosity to see Jesus? What does his action of climbing the tree say about his heart?

Jesus: Seeking One Man (v.5)

4. Why do you think Jesus stopped specifically for Zacchaeus? What do Jesus' words and actions teach us about grace and divine appointments? How does this challenge our ideas about who "deserves" Jesus' attention?

A Radical Transformation (vv.6–10)

5. How did Zacchaeus respond to Jesus' invitation? What changes do we see in Zacchaeus' life and priorities? Why does Jesus declare, *"Today salvation has come to this house"*?

Reflection & Application

- 6. Where might Jesus be trying to "interrupt" your life today?
- 7. Are there areas where you're wearing a mask like Zacchaeus?
- 8. What does it mean to you that Jesus sees you and calls your name?
- 9. Have you experienced moving from curiosity about Jesus to commitment? What changed? Share your story of your holy interruption and transformation. How can your own "holy interruption" become a testimony to others?

Prayer Focus

Pray for a heart open to God's divine interruptions. Ask for courage to seek Jesus with sincerity and urgency. Thank God that He seeks and saves the lost.
