



## Look Back and Look Ahead | Philippians 3:1-14

1. How long have you been part of this church, and what first drew you here? What is one thing you appreciate about this church community? Share one way you have experienced God's faithfulness recently (in church life or personally).
2. For those who have been here longer: What changes have you seen over the years, and where have you seen God at work? For newer members: What has surprised or encouraged you since joining?
3. What do you think this church does especially well in reflecting Christ? Is there a particular memory, service, or season that stands out as meaningful to you? How has being part of this church helped you grow spiritually?
4. Read the passage again together. What strikes you as you read?
5. Paul looks back on his past achievements but calls them "loss" compared to knowing Christ. What past experiences, traditions, or memories have shaped your story?
6. Who are the faithful people from previous years whose legacy still blesses us today?
7. What might God be asking us to lay down so we can move forward faithfully?
8. Paul presses on toward the prize of God's calling. What do we think God might be calling our church to in this next season?
9. Looking back, where have you seen God's faithfulness most clearly in your own life? What is one thing God is calling you personally to press toward right now?
10. What is one hope you have for our church and one way we can pray for it this week?
