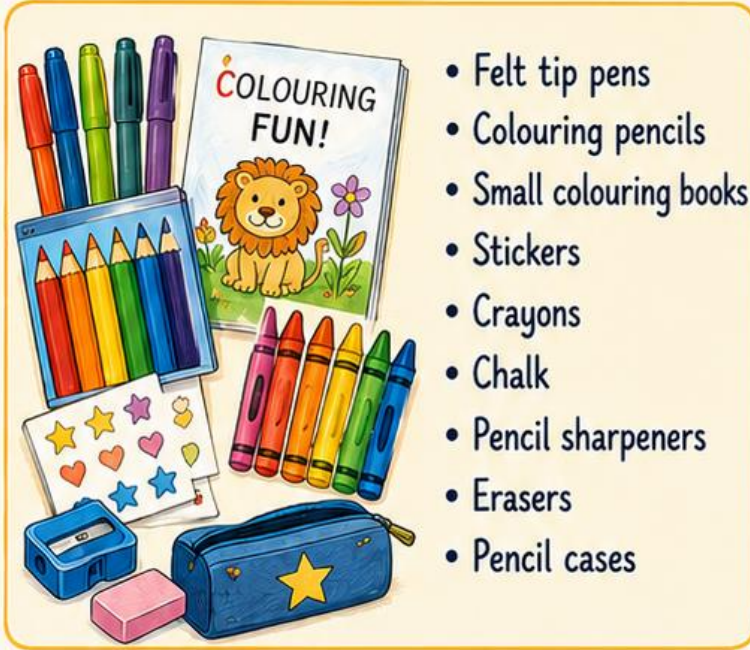
Choose recyclable gift wrap and greeting cards.
