- 1. Reflect back on the teaching from 24th of January, "Jesus is Gospel." How, if at all, did this teaching impact the past 7-10 days of your life? [Jesus + nothing = everything]
- 2. What is Paul writing about in verses 15-23? What jumps out or strikes you afresh?
- 3. What does it mean to be the *image of God*?
- 4. How does Jesus help us to know more about who God is?
- 5. Tom used a parallel between Adam and Jesus to talk about the image of God, how does this help us to understand more about who Jesus is?
- 6. How does Jesus' supremacy affect our lives?
- 7. What do you think is meant by the "fullness of God" and what implications does this have for who Jesus is?
- 8. How does knowing of God's desire to reconcile with us affect the way that we live? Does it change the way we pray or read the Bible?
- 9. How should we respond knowing the great lengths Christ went to in order to bring us back to him?
- 10. What does "continuing in the faith" look like?
- 11. Spend some time reflecting on who Christ is and give some prayers of praise to him.
