

Joshua: Are We There Yet? | Stepping Out In Faith | Joshua 1

- 1. This new series was set up using the picture of a journey, asking the question, 'are we there yet?' When it comes to thinking about your relationship with the Lord how would you interpret and answer the question, 'am I there yet?'
- 2. Read Joshua 1 together, and then reflecting on the preach and the text, what stands out most for you in these words as significant? Why so?
- 3. What insights do you have from reflecting on the nature of the relationship between Moses and Joshua? What relationships do you have which could reflect something of a similar approach to discipleship for yourself and someone else?
- 4. Reflecting on verses 7-8, how do we ensure we remain faithful in this area? Share your experiences and ideas.
- 5. Step Up (v1-9) Joshua had to step up into his calling as a leader. What did he need for this to be able to happen? Share how has the Lord called and equipped you.
- 6. Move Out (v10) Joshua must move out and take action as a leader. What are the practical next steps the Lord is leading you to take in working out your calling?
- 7. Stay Together (v11-18) Joshua instructed all the tribes to go even though some were already in the land of their inheritance. How are we as a church or as a home group going 'together' into the spaces and places the Lord is leading?
- 8. How is our church community encouraging you to live out your calling? How can you encourage each other in this area?
- 9. Finally, we were challenged to think about those who can help disciple us or who we could disciple and invest in. Has the Lord put a name specifically on your heart? Share your conviction and pray together for the opportunity of a conversation with the person the Lord has identified to you.
